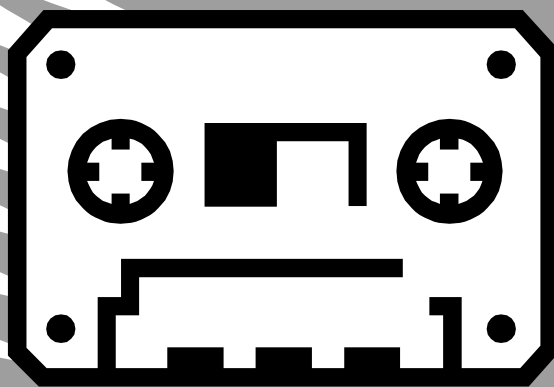
AUDIO DIGITIZING PROJECT – *The Sound Model: Collaborative Infrastructure for Digital Audio* will digitize at least 2000 hours of audio, including oral histories, and provide access through a shared infrastructure being built by CDP.
