Preserving More with Less

Through collaboration from Connecting to Collections (C2C) initiative, the Society of Rocky Mountain Archivists is pleased to present the Spring 2010 conference and workshop *Preserving More with Less: Discussions on Collections, Accessions and Sustainability in the Archive*. Workshop presenter Victoria Montana Ryan will elaborate on a diverse range of subjects related to sustainable practices in a museum and archival setting, including discussions on low-cost/ no-cost environmental control improvements, preventative care, and the storage and handling of digital media. Shannon Bowen, Laura Uglean Jackson, and Victoria Montana Ryan will also offer a panel discussion, moderated by Karen Jones, covering the development of collection policy, curatorial decision-making, and the ethics of deaccessioning in both archive and museum realms. Cliff Hight will offer his insights on how his institution, The Royal Gorge Regional Museum and History Center, has increased community involvement with their archival holdings. At the end of the day, conference participants will have the opportunity to tour the CF&I Archives and Steelworks Museum, a must-see in Pueblo!

Presenters

Victoria Montana Ryan has served as Assistant Professor for the Conservation of Paintings and Wall Paintings at Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario and was also previously employed at the University of Denver's Rocky Mountain Conservation Center where she was adjunct faculty and conservator of paintings. In addition to being a Fellow member of AIC, she also currently serves on AIC's Green Task Force (for sustainability in conservation). Additionally she is a member of WAAC and member of the Canadian Association for the Conservation of Cultural Property.

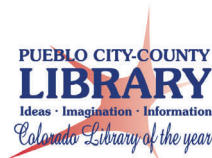
Shannon Bowen has worked as an archivist for the University of Wyoming- American Heritage Center since 2002. Beginning her work in the arrangement and description unit, she transferred to the reference department in 2003. Shannon is passionate about patron access and acquainting non-traditional user groups with the joys of primary source research. Her research interests include the relationship between technical and public services in archives and the assessment of public services, and she currently serves as SRMA's Archives Month Coordinator.

Laura Uglean Jackson works at the American Heritage Center, University of Wyoming, where she is an assistant archivist in the arrangement and description department. She is also university archivist for the University of Wyoming. She has worked at the AHC since July 2007, when she was hired to work on a grant to deaccession collections. She currently chairs the SAA Deaccessioning and Reappraisal Development and Review Team, which is responsible for drafting a professional standard for reappraisal and deaccessioning. She holds an MLIS from Simmons College.

Cliff Hight is the Archivist/Curator at the Royal Gorge Regional Museum and History Center in Cañon City, Colorado, and is finishing his term as secretary on the SRMA board.

Karen Jones is the Collections Conservator at Jefferson County Public Library since 1981. A professional associate member of AIC, Karen also has a private book and paper conservation practice. She is currently Preservation rep for SRMA, and has been involved in preservation outreach since 1990.
